WHITE, J.A. *Nightbooks*. 294p. [2019].

A boy is imprisoned by a witch and must tell her a new scary story each night to stay alive.

BALLARINI, Joe. A *Babysitters Guide To Monster Hunting*. 338p. [2017].

The Last Kids on Earth meets Goosebumps in this hilarious new series about a secret society of babysitters who protect kids from the monsters that really do live under their beds

ALEXANDER, William. A *Festival of Ghosts*. 262p. [2018].

Rosa Ramona Diaz, the ghost appeasing assistant librarian, has unleashed all the ghosts who were previously shut out of the small town of Ingot. Now ghosts are everywhere, and the town's living residents are either learning to cope or trying to do the one thing no one can successfully do--banish the ghosts. [sequal: *A Properly Unhaunted Place*]

SCHWAB, Victoria. *City of Ghosts*. 285p. [2018].

Ever since her near-fatal drowning, Cassidy has been able to pull back the "Veil" that separates the living from the dead and see ghosts, not that she wants to, and she was really looking forward to a ghost-free summer at the beach; however her parents are going to start filming a TV series about the world's most haunted places, starting with Edinburgh with its graveyards, castles, and restless phantoms--and Cass and her personal ghost companion, Jacob, are about to find out that a city of old ghosts can be a very dangerous place indeed.

BALLARINI, Joe *Beasts & Geeks*. 321p. [2018].

Kelly's been a celebrity ever since she defeated the Boogeyman and his army of nightmares on Halloween. But now all the other monsters want revenge. And if Kelly's going to survive Babysitter Bootcamp, she'll have to face the Spider Queen, whose wicked web turns her parents, BFF, and middle-school teachers into mindless minions. McAnulty, Stacy. *Goldie Blox And The Haunted Hacks!* 238p. [2018].

The Problem: Of course Goldie Blox doesn't believe in ghosts. But in order to save the cool old Bloxtown Inn, she will have to prove that it's haunted.

***Scream And Scream Again .: : spooky stories from Mystery Writers of America*. 396p. [2018].**

A harrowing array of scary stories that all have one thing in common: each either begins or ends with a scream!

KENT, Derek. *Scary School*. 233 [2011].

Describes a year at Scary School, where werewolves, zombies, and humans mingle and the teachers range from dragons to vampires. [First of Series.]

BARNHOLDT, Karen. *Girl Meets Ghost*. 213p. [2013].

There's an old saying that "dead men tell no tales"--but that saying is definitely not true. Just ask twelve-year-old Kendall Williams, who can't get dead people to stop talking to her, no matter how politely she asks. It's pretty frustrating being able to hear and see people that no one else can. For one thing, her friends and family think she's going crazy. And for another, being spotted by your crush while talking to (seemingly) no one is positively mortifying. But Kendall is going to have to learn how to deal, because the only way to quiet the dead is to help them.

STINE, R.L.. *Just Beyond. The Scare School*. 144p. [2019.] [Graphic Novel]

Surviving middle school is hard enough but when Jess, Josh, and Marco encounter a strange and deadly creature wandering the halls of The Scare School, it leads them to a sinister secret in the boiler room...

MIEDOSO, Andres. *Desmond Cole Ghost Patrol Campfire Stories*. [Series] [2019].

ICamping with Desmond Cole is a lot of fun, until he starts telling ghost stories around the campfire. Most kids tell creepy stories that are totally fake, but Desmond tells totally true stories that will give you goosebumps. So, settle in while Desmond, Andres, and their ghost-friend, Zax, take turns trying to tell the scariest story of all.

SHEPHERD, Kat. *The Shadow hand*. 203p. [2018.] [Series]

Got chills? Babysitting can be a real nightmare in this spooky middle grade series For Rebecca Chin, babysitting has always been fun. But one night, a thunderstorm knocks the power out while she's watching baby Kyle, and creepy things begin to happen in the house.
